

# Fibre facilities to be expanded at Kharach, Kosamba

The company is also interested in expanding its cellulosic fibre facilities at Kharach and Kosamba in Surat district with a proposed investment of Rs 600 crore with employment potential for 300 individuals. The facility is expected to be completed and commissioned by December 2018," the state government said in a statement.

Textiles-to-retail conglomerate Arvind Ltd inked an MoU for a first of its kind mega apparel facility, under the new Gujarat Apparel policy. The company intends to infuse Rs 300 crore in two phases for the project, which will come up at Dehgam near Ahmedabad and will have a capacity to produce 24 million garments once it is fully operational. "We plan to commence commercial production in the fourth quarter of 2018 and we plan to create 10,000 jobs, a majority of which will be for women. We are confident that with such a conducive policy Gujarat will emerge as a major destination for garmenting," said Kulin Lalbhai, executive director, Arvind Ltd.

A agrochemical sector company also signed an MoU proposing a facility to produce agrochemicals and intermediates at Dahej, Bharuch with a Rs 6,000 crore investment. The project is expected to provide direct and indirect employment to about 10,000 people. All the three agreements were signed at Gandinagar in presence of chief minister Vijay Rupani.

# Grasim Industries, Arvind announce mega investments in Gujarat

Grasim lays down ₹4,100-crore investment plan; Arvind plans ₹300-crore garment unit in the State

Ahmedabad, October 17

Two of the leading garment players in the country have announced combined investments of over ₹4,400 crore to be made in Gujarat.

Aditya Birla Group's textile arm, Grasim Industries announced its intentions to invest ₹4,100 crore towards setting up two plants each at Vilayat GIDC and Kharach-Kosamba in Baruch district.

An MoU was signed with the State government, which had recently announced new Garments & Apparels Policy 2017 to boost employment in the garmenting sector in the State and encourage value-addition from textiles.

As per the MoU, Grasim will employ about 1,300 people directly and indirectly at the facilities which are likely to be commissioned in 2018 and 2020, respectively.

"Investment by such a large industrial group will attract investments by several small industries as the ancillary units. This will boost small businesses and employment in the State," said a State government communique here.

Grasim is planning to set up man-made fibre plant in the State.

Meanwhile, a separate MoU was signed by denim major Arvind Ltd announcing its plans to set up a mega apparel factory with a proposed investment of ₹300 crore and produce 24 million garments per annum.

The mega apparel factory will come up at Dahegam near Ahmedabad. Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani and Arvind's Executive Directors Kulin Lalbhai and Punit Lalbhai signed the MoU at the State Secretariat in Gandhinagar on Tuesday.

Detailing the investment plans, Kulin Lalbhai said, "We plan to commence commercial production in the fourth quarter of 2018 and we plan to create 10,000 jobs, a majority of which will be women. We are excited to support the Gujarat Apparel policy whose aim is to create one lakh jobs in Gujarat."

Both the companies will set up production facilities in the state.

Grasim, a flagship company of the Aditya Birla Group, is planning to set up man-made fibreplants in Vilayat GIDC and Kharach-Kosamba in the state's Bharuch district. The company signed an MoU with the Gujarat government on Tuesday to invest about ₹4,100 crore.

As perits MoU with the state government, Grasim will employ about 1,300 people directly and indirectly at the facilities which are likely to be commissioned in 2018 and 2020, respectively.

Denim major Arvind on Tuesday announced its plans to set up a mega apparel factory with a proposed investment of ₹300 crore in the state and produce 24 million garments per annum.

"This agreement will generate employment in the state and boost the small businesses as the investment by such a large industrial group will attract investments by several small industries as the ancillary units," a state government communique said.

The mega apparel factory of Arvind will come up at Dahegam near Ahmedabad.



#### Grasim, Arvind line up new investments in Gujarat

Grasim Industries and Arvind Ltd have lined up fresh investments in Gujarat totalling Rs4,400 crore, giving a boost to two recent policy decisions by the state





Ahmedabad: Two of the country's leading textiles and clothing companies Aditya Birla group's Grasim Industries and Arvind Ltd, have lined up fresh investments in Gujarat totalling Rs4.400 croe, giving a major boost to two recent policy decisions by the state government.

"The Gujarat government had in September decided to extend its textile policy by a year as its five-year duration got completed. In October, Gujarat unveiled a new policy specific to the garments and apparels sector. While Grasim's projects will bring big investment, Arvind's projects will help the government get closer to its goal of job creation," said a senior state government official on condition of anonymity.

Grasim Industries on Tuesday signed an agreement with the Gujarat government to invest Rs4,100 crore for setting up two factories, one of which will come up on Gujarat Industrial Development Corp. (GIDC) land in Bharuch district while the other will come up in Surat, according to a state government release

A spokesperson for Grasim Industries confirmed that the company had signed agreements with the Gujarat government for setting up two factories.

Grasim's plans come close to the state government's decision to extend its Textile Policy 2012, which ended in September this year. The policy that offers sops and other incentives to textile manufacturers has been extended by a year.

Grasim aims to set up man-made fibre facilities in the state and will employ about 1,300 people for the two factories, one of which will be commissioned in 2018, while the other will be operational in 2020, according to the government release.

Gujarat is a leader in cotton production. It is also a hub for textile manufacturing in the country, with 2.5 million spindles installed.

In a separate announcement, Arvind Ltd said in a media statement Tuesday that it has entered into an agreement with the Gujarat government to set up a "mega apparel factory".

The Rs300 crore project will come up at Dehgam in Gandhinagar district with a capacity to produce 24 million garments once it is fully operational, the company said in a statement.

The company said that its decision comes on the heels of the new apparels and garments policy announced by the government earlier in October.

The new Apparels and Garments Policy 2017 that was unveiled by chief minister Vijay Rupani on 11 October is expected to draw investments to the tune of Rs20,000 crore and provide jobs to about 100,000 people.

Under the new policy, the government will provide incentive for garment unit owners for generating employment by providing subsidy in wages. A special provision has been made in the policy wherein women workers will be paid Rs4,000 per month and male workers will be paid Rs3,300 per month. This promotion of assistance will be for a period of five years. Other incentives in the policy include subsidy in interest, exemption of stamp duty and partial relief in electricity duty.

In a statement, Kulin Lalbhai, executive director of Arvind, said, "We plan to commence commercial production in the fourth quarter of 2018 and we plan to create 10,000 jobs, a majority of which will be women. We are excited to support the Gujarat apparel policy whose aim is to create 10,000 jobs in Gujarat. We are confident that with such a conducive policy Gujarat will emerge as a major destination for garmenting."





Three MoUs — committing an investment of more than Rs 10,000 crore, and promising to create over 21,000 jobs — were signed by different companies with the Gujarat state government on Tuesday.

Agrochemicals producer United Phosphorus Limited signed an

MoU to invest Rs 6,000 crore for setting up an agrochemical and intermediates production facility in Dahej 3 chemical zone, an official statement said.

As per the MoU, signed in the presence of Chief Minister Vijay Rupani, the company will be allotted 6 lakh sqmt of land for a production facility which will create 10,000 direct and indirect employment opportunities. Grasim Industries, the flagship company of Aditya Birla Group, signed an MoU to set up two viscose staple fibre manufacturing facilities in the state.

Officials said that the company will be allotted land in Vilayat GIDC in Bharuch and Kharach-Kosamba for both facilities. The two facilities, one of which will be operational by 2018, and the other one two years later, will create 1,300 jobs.

Ahmedabad-based textile major, Arvind Ltd, also signed an MoU to set up an apparel manufacturing unit in Dehgam with an investment of Rs 300 crore. The facility will have the capacity to produce 2.4 crore garments a year, and would create 10,000 jobs. Kulin Lalbhai, executive director of Arvind Ltd, said that the facility will commence commercial production in the fourth quarter of 2018.

The MoU comes a few days after the state government announced the Garments & Apparel Policy 2017, aimed at boosting apparel manufacturing in the state and creating a target of 1,00,000 jobs.

Government officials said that the three projects will also boost investment in ancillary industries and creating more jobs for the local population.

Just weeks ahead of the Assembly elections in the state, the BJP government on Tuesday said that it has signed MoUs worth Rs 10,400 crore with three companies that have the potential of creating 21,300 job opportunities in the state. The MoUs were signed in presence of Chief Minister Vijay Rupani.

The three companies which have signed the MoUs include United Phosphorous Limited (UPL), Grasim Industries Limited (GIL) and Arvind Limited. As per the Rs 6,000 crore MoU signed with the UPL, the company will set up a plant to produce agro-chemicals and intermediates at Gujarat Industrial

Development Corporation's Chemical Zone in Dahej. The government said that the GIDC will provide company 6 lakh square metre land to set up the chemical plant.


